Applicable for Cargo handled at the Puerto Rico Facility, a Carrier Loaded Consolidation/Unload Fee shall be assessed upon shipper's request to load cargo into an exclusive use container/trailer or to transfer cargo from one piece of equipment into carrier's container. This charge does not apply for specialized equipment.

**Consolidation/Unloading Charge** includes unloading, count, inspection for damages, receiving, warehousing and stuffing of cargo into Carrier's Container (to include Shipper Own Equipment).
