Following the third (3rd) business day after vessel completes discharge on Southbound shipments (US to Puerto Rico) the Carrier will assess an Energy Charge of \$150.00 per day when the Carrier is required to maintain operating reefers in their terminal facilities.

On Northbound shipments from Puerto Rico to the US the Carrier will allow 3 free business days of Energy charges starting the day after the container is delivered to the terminal. The Carrier will then assess an Energy Charge of \$150.00 per day when the Carrier is required to maintain operating reefers in their terminal facilities.

Energy Charges Shall Be Suspended when the Carrier Delays Or Cancels A Scheduled Sailing.

## IN THE UNITED STATES:

Following the third (3rd) business days after vessel completes discharge on Northbound shipments (Puerto Rico to US) the Carrier will assess an Energy Charge of \$150.00 per day when the Carrier is required to maintain operating reefers in their terminal facilities.

On Southbound shipments from the US to Puerto Rico the Carrier will allow 3 free business days of Energy charges starting the day after the container is delivered to the terminal. The Carrier will then assess an Energy Charge of \$150.00 per day when the Carrier is required to maintain operating reefers in their terminal facilities.

Energy Charges Shall Be Suspended when the Carrier Delays Or Cancels A Scheduled Sailing.

The aforementioned Energy Charges will apply to all open tariff and contract shipments.
