## **Prohibited or Restricted Articles**

Carrier reserves the right to carry the following articles which it may consider as restricted or prohibitive.

- 1. Freight which because of its inherent vice is likely to contaminate or otherwise damage containers or other cargo.

- 3. - 4. Tires that can be defined as used, defective, scrap, salvage, waste, or are otherwise other than new. Shipments described in section D of this rule may be accepted at carrier's discretion and must be prepaid prior to acceptance of shipment.
