

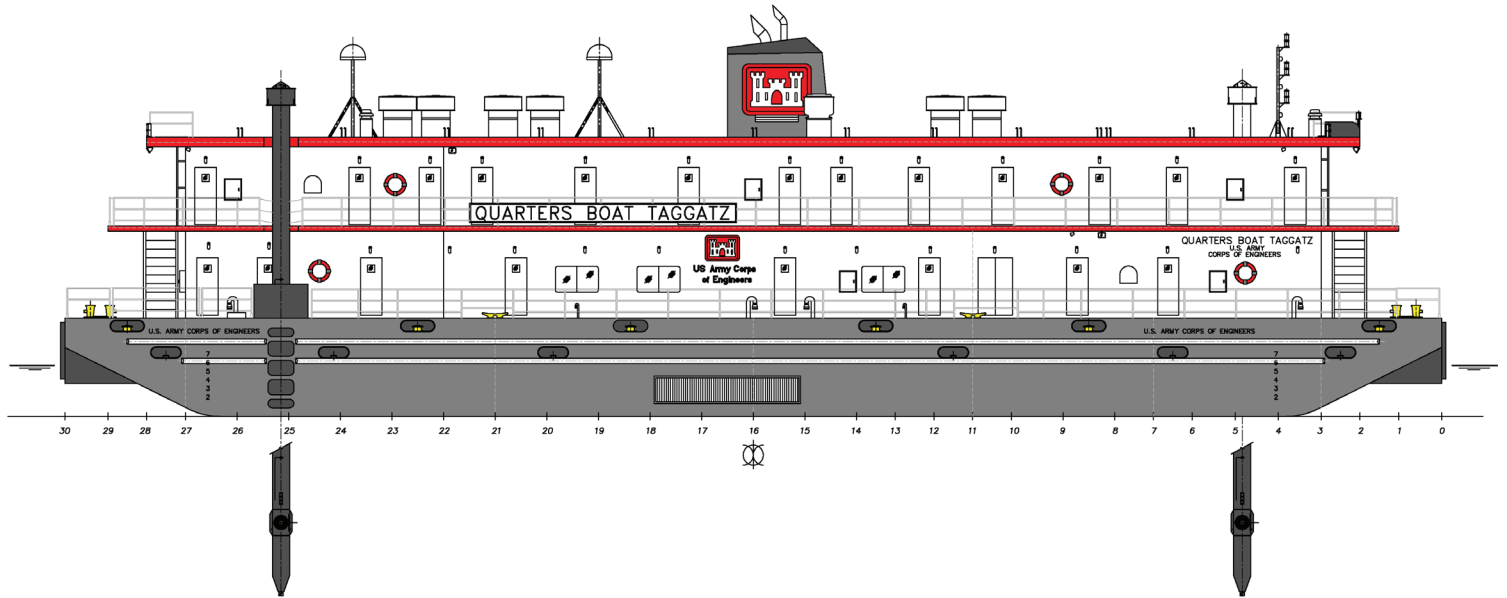

Accommodations Barge

The *Taggatz* accommodations barge was designed for the U.S. Army Corp or Engineers - St. Paul District, and built by Patti Shipyard in 2008. In addition to quarters, the vessel includes a mess with seating for 40, a galley, a ship's office, a lounge, a laundry, an exercise space, and various mechanical systems spaces. The *Taggatz* is equipped with two spuds to anchor the vessel at dredging sites.
