Applicable for Cargo handled at the Puerto Rico Facility, a Carrier Loaded Consolidation/Unload Fee shall be assessed upon shipper’s request to load cargo into an exclusive use container/trailer or to transfer cargo from one piece of equipment into carrier’s container. This charge does not apply for specialized equipment.

Consolidation/Unloading Charge includes unloading, count, inspection for damages, receiving, warehousing and stuffing of cargo into Carrier’s Container (to include Shipper Own Equipment). Note: Carrier will provide up to \$35.00 worth of dunnage for blocking and bracing. Any additional dunnage required to secure customers load for safe transport shall be for the account of the cargo.
