A charge of \$25 per seal will be added to the Bill of Lading for containers delivered with non-compliant seals on the container. If shipping internationally, shipper must affix a compliant high security seal on containers that meets the International Organization for Standardization (ISO) requirements.

This link from the U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) shows what a high security seal looks like: [CBP Link](#) Crowley is a CTPAT-certified carrier; therefore, all shippers must tender or accept containers for international shipment only with high security seals that meet or exceed ISO17712 standards.

This \$25 fee covers the cost of the carrier to place a compliant High Security seal on the container. Shipments to/from Puerto Rico are excluded.
