Rule Name:	Container Storage in Carrier's Foreign Container Yard			

COSTA RICA

When carriers are requested to store containers at their Moin Port, Limon CY or San Jose CY, the following will apply after three (3) calendar days of Free Storage/Parking:

- Dry Containers/Trailers: \$10.00 per day per CL/TL.
- Refrigerated Equipment: \$15.00 per day per CL/TL.

If cargo arrives at Moin port without export documents, DUA, on file and is diverted to local container yard for storage, the following charges will apply:

- \$100/Dry per day per CL (1 to 7 days)
- \$100/Reefer per day per CL + \$90 Energy per day per CL (1 to 7 days)

HONDURAS

Upon arrival in Carriers yard in Puerto Cortes, San Pedro Sula, and Tegucigalpa in Honduras, the customer is allowed five (5) calendar days Free Time. After this period, a charge for parking/container storage charges as follows:

Dry Containers/Trailers:

- 6-10 days - \$10/day per TEU
- 11+ days - \$15/day per TEU

Refrigerated Equipment:

- 6-10 days - \$15/day per TEU
- 11+ days - \$20/day per TEU

GUATEMALA

When carriers are requested to store containers at Guatemala ports, storage charges will apply after three (3) calendar days of free time

- **IMPORTS:** storage charges will begin on the third day after complete vessel discharge for imports
- **EXPORTS:** storage charges will begin on cargo received more than three (3) days prior to the scheduled sailing.

After this period, the following charges will apply:

- Dry Containers/Trailers: \$35.00 per day per CL/TL.
- Refrigerated Equipment: \$35.00 per day per CL/TL.

This charge does not cover the cost of providing electricity and the Energy Maintenance Charge [Rule FMC 34.5] per container if applicable would be in addition to the above-mentioned charges.
