<b>Rule Name:</b>	<b>Battery Jump Start Service Charge</b>			

In the event a vehicle tendered for shipment is presented in operable condition but, at the time of loading, is unable to be driven under its own power due to a dead or depleted battery, Carrier may, at its sole discretion, perform a jump start solely to facilitate handling.

A Battery Jump Start Service Charge of \$50 per vehicle shall be assessed for such service, in addition to any other freight rates, surcharges, assessorial charges, and fees.

*Carrier shall not be liable for any loss, damage, delay, mechanical failure, electrical malfunction, or diminished condition of the vehicle arising out of or related to the performance or attempted performance of a jump start. Performance of such service shall not be construed as an acceptance of responsibility for the condition, operability, or seaworthiness of the vehicle.*
