<b>Rule Name:</b>	Additional Cargo Loaded In/On Vehicles or NIT			

### **Privately Owned and Dealer Vehicles, Passenger Vehicles**

- Carrier will not accept additional cargo loaded inside passenger vehicles, including cars, SUVs or truck cabs, other than normal emergency equipment.
- Cargo loaded inside the passenger compartment of any vehicle is strictly prohibited and will result in rejection at the terminal.
- Vehicles received with cargo loaded inside passenger areas will not be accepted and will be rejected regardless of cargo type or value.
- If, without the Carrier's knowledge, a Dealer Vehicle or Privately-Owned Vehicle is received with additional articles other than emergency equipment, Shipper/Owner does so at their own risk for loss or damage of the goods. Shipper/Owner also acknowledges that any documentation presented to Carrier indicating cargo value does not constitute consent by the Carrier, expressed or implied. Claims will not be accepted for Goods. Insurance on the Goods does not apply.

### **Additional Cargo Charge: PUERTO RICO ONLY**

- Additional cargo is permitted only when loaded in designated cargo areas, subject to the Additional Cargo Charge of \$500 per unit, for any size, applicable to the following:
  - Trucks that contain freight loaded in the bed of the truck
  - Cargo vans containing freight in the cargo-designated area
  - Trailers containing cargo with VIN number (e.g. motorcycle)
  - NIT that contains freight that is not part of the unit
- Additional cargo is not permitted inside passenger compartments, including enclosed cab areas, seating areas, or interior areas designed for occupant
- Additional cargo must be:
  - Properly declared and manifested by the shipper on the dock receipt
  - Sealed, locked, and securely blocked/braced
- The additional cargo will move at the Shipper/Owners risk for loss or damage of the goods. Claims will not be accepted for Goods. Insurance will not apply on the cargo.
- Hazardous material, firearms and household goods are forbidden.
- Crowley reserves the right to reject any unit that is unsafe, leaning, improperly blocked/braced by shipper, or contains undeclared cargo prior to the arrival to the load port.
- VIN Numbers of added vehicles/motorcycles must be accessible for verification
