- A. Actual tender for delivery constitutes the notice of the arrival of a shipment at its destination, except that on freight moving under instruction for "No Delivery Service", the following RULES will apply:
- 1. Notice of arrival of the shipment at the destination specified on the bill of lading will be given by mail, or at carrier's option by telephone to the notify party at the address, designated by the shipper on the bill of lading.
 - 2. The notice will specify the point of origin, consignor and commodity.
- B. If freight cannot be delivered because of the consignee's refusal or inability to accept it or because the carrier cannot locate the consignee, or if freight cannot be transported because of an error or omission on the part of the consignor, the carrier will make a diligent effort to notify the consignor promptly that the freight is being stored at the risk and expense of consignor and the freight.
