FREE TIME

1. The Free Time for Outbound Dry, Open Top or Flatbed Trailers or chassis is seven (7) calendar days.
2. The Free Time for Outbound Refrigerated Trailers is four (4) calendar days.
3. The Free Time for Outbound Tank Trailers is three (3) calendar days.
4. Free Time will commence the first 8:00 a.m. following the day the container or chassis is dispatched to the Shipper or his Agent.

DETENTION

After the expiration of Free Time stipulated in Paragraph 1 and 2 above, the following Detention Charges per 24 hours or fraction thereof will be assessed until trailer is returned to Carrier's Terminal and interchanged to Carrier.

20' Dry - \$70
40' Dry - \$110
20' Reefer - \$160 days 1-14, \$210 over 14 days
40' Reefer - \$160 days 1-14, \$210 over 14 days
Special Equipment - \$175

If trailer is returned to Carrier's Terminal and cannot be laden on Carrier's next available sailing because cargo is being held awaiting proper documentation or when Shipper or Consignee instructs Carrier to hold said cargo, Detention Charges will be assessed from the normal expiration of Free Time to the date of sailing.
