<p>Freight Forwarder's Advance charges may be accepted on the bill of lading on freight collect shipments only. It is understood that the carrier is not acting as an agent for the freight forwarder and will accept no responsibility for the collection or pursuit of the monies owed the freight forwarders.</p> <p>In addition, no Freight Forwarder's Advance charges will be accepted after release of the bills of lading, nor will any advance charges be deducted by the freight forwarder from any subsequent prepaid shipments due to the inability of the carrier to collect same from any previous shipment.</p> <p>The limit of advance charges that may be allowed on any bill of lading will be limited to the amount of the base ocean freight. In addition a 15% collection surcharge will be applicable on all PBA's. Advance charges may include inlands.</p> <p>The bill of lading must be accompanied by a detailed invoice of the freight forwarder charges and duly signed by an officer of the company. No advance charges will be allowed without said invoice.</p>
