Prohibited Restricted Articles

Except where prior arrangements have been concluded with the carrier and the carrier has determined it has safe and adequate equipment and storage to handle the shipments, the following articles will not be accepted for transportation under this Tariff:

A. Explosives, Inflammable, Dangerous or Objectionable. Goods will be accepted for transportation only after prior booking arrangements have been made with and carrier has accepted for transport any goods which in its judgement are objectionable or likely to injure the vessel, docks or other cargo or for which in carrier's judgement it has no safe and suitable storage, and only when shipping containers, marking, and packaging requirements for, and handling, stowage and transportation of Explosive, and Hazardous and Dangerous articles other than Explosives, are in accordance with the rules and regulations prescribed in carrier OS&D manual of the Governing Publications of this Tariff.

- B. Freight which because of its inherent vice is likely to contaminate or otherwise damage containers or other cargo.
- C. Live animals or fowls or birds, domestic or wild.
- D. All goods, including letters, parcels, packages or pieces with or without postage stamps affixed, which prior to receipt by carrier have been received by and entered in any Post Office, except when consignor and consignee are Post Offices.
- E. Bank bills, coin or currency, deeds, drafts, notes or valuable paper of any kind; jewelry, including costume or novelty jewelry; postage stamps or letters with or without postage stamps affixed; precious metals or articles manufactured therefrom; precious stones; revenue stamps; works of art; antiques, or other related or unrelated old, rare, or precious articles of extraordinary value, except when prior arrangements have been concluded with carrier.
- F. Except as otherwise provided, Personal Effects and Household Goods cannot be contained in vehicles bound for shipment.
