Bill of Lading Commodity Description

Description of commodities on all copies of the Bill of Lading determine the rates applicable. Verification of bill of lading description shall be by comparison with Customs Declaration or Custom Entry. Commodity description may be corrected in the event of mis-declaration only when supported by Custom Declaration or Custom entry. Trade name are not acceptable commodity descriptions and Shippers are required to declare their commodities by their generally accepted common names.

The Shipper will be liable for and shall hold the Carrier harmless from any fine, loss, damage, delay, expense or liability incurred by or levied upon the Carrier or the cargo for non-compliance with U.S or Foreign Customs or other regulations resulting from the Shipper's late presentation of the export declaration.

Where cargo is delayed by any governmental agency because of incomplete, inaccurate or late-filed documentation required to be provided by the Shipper, the Shipper shall be liable for any pier demurrage charges which may be assessed by the terminal operator and/or carrier.
